PRICES ORDER No. 142

being

A PRICES ORDER relating to the maximum retail price for aviation gasoline.

MADE by the Price Controller under the provisions of the *Prices Regulation Act 1949*, as amended to date, to come into operation on the date of publication in the *Government Gazette*.

1. DEFINITIONS.

In this Order—

"aviation gasoline" includes any substance normally sold as aviation gasoline whether or not containing additives of any kind;

"supplier" in relation to aviation gasoline, means a person or a firm who sells aviation gasoline for the purpose of consumption or use;

"retail" means for the purpose of consumption or use.

2. MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICE.

(i) Where aviation gasoline is supplied at a locality specified in Column 1 of Schedule I, the maximum price per gallon at which the aviation gasoline may be supplied is the maximum retail selling price specified in Column 2 of that Schedule in relation to the locality concerned; and

(ii) Where the maximum price of any quantity of aviation gasoline, supplied at any one time, calculated in accordance with Subclause (i) is an amount involving a fraction of a toea, the supplier may charge to the next whole toea; and

(iii) Where aviation gasoline is supplied at a locality specified in Column 1 of Schedule II, the maximum surcharge for each aircraft specified in Column 2 of that Schedule in relation to the locality concerned may be charged by the supplier in addition to the maximum retail selling price specified in Subclause (i).

3. SUPPLY TO GOVERNMENT.

Nothing in this Order applies to or relates to the supply of aviation gasoline to the Government, to Australia or to a Statutory Authority of the Government or of Australia.
