NATIONAL CONSTITUTION

Organic Law on Provincial Government

CHARTER

GRANTING PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT

to

BOUGAINVILLE PROVINCE

(known as North Solomons)

WHEREAS immediately before the commencement of the Organic Law on Provincial Government (called in this Charter "the Organic Law") a provincial government body under the *National Provincial Government (Preparatory Arrangements) Act 1974* was established in respect of the Bougainville Province (called in this Charter, in accordance with the wishes of the people of that Province, "North Solomons"):

AND WHEREAS by Section 109 (*first authorizations of grant of provincial governments*) of the Organic Law it is provided that the National Parliament shall be deemed to have made a resolution under Section 4 (*authorization of grant of provincial government*) of the Organic Law authorizing the National Executive Council to approve the grant of provincial government to all provinces in respect of which such provincial government bodies were established immediately before the commencement of the Organic Law, and accordingly Charters of Provincial Government may be granted under and in accordance with Section 6 (*grant of provincial government*) of the Organic Law:

AND WHEREAS on 11th August, 1977 the Provincial Constituent Assembly for North Solomons adopted, in accordance with Part III of the Organic Law, a Constitution for North Solomons that is not inconsistent with the National Constitution and the Organic Law:

AND WHEREAS that Constitution particularly stated that in adopting the Provincial Constitution the people of North Solomons, acting through their Provincial Constituent Assembly—

"Acknowledge and declare that (they) will uphold, guard and maintain the unity of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea and its Constitution:

"Understand and assert that fundamentally that unity and that Constitution, and the relationship between Provincial and Central Authorities, are founded on principles of complementarity, as more particularly described in the *Statement of Principles of Complementarity*. . . ."

AND WHEREAS the *Statement of Principles of Complementarity* set out in the Constitution of North Solomons states in part—

" . . . In the whole that makes up a Society or a Nation, therefore—

each part must recognize and respect the roles of the other parts and of the whole in the well-being of the Society or of the Nation—

" . . . in relation to the political and constitutional organization of Papua New Guinea—

Provinces are parts of the Nation considered as a whole.

Provincial Governments and the Central Government are necessarily partners in the government of the Nation, and one is not inferior in its nature to the other.

The existence and effectiveness both of Provincial Governments and of a Central Government, each with its own peculiar and necessary role and functions, are inherent in and fundamental to the constitutional life of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea as we understand and acknowledge it.

"Accordingly, in serving the people of the Nation through the State—

The Provincial Governments and the Central Government are and must be complementary and equally necessary to each other, and are not and must not be opposed to each other.

For the well-being of the Nation as a whole and of the peoples of the individual Provinces, it is the duty of those Governments to work in co-operation and with goodwill and understanding towards each other, and not in competition one with another."

AND WHEREAS the National Government has welcomed and accepted that statement and the concept of partnership as the basis of the relationship between Central and Provincial authority:

Granting Provincial Government—*continued*

NOW THEREFORE I, Tore Lokoloko, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by the Organic Law on Provincial Government and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance, with the advice of the National Executive Council, by this Charter grant provincial government to North Solomons.

Organic Law on the Terms and Conditions of Employment of Judges

DETERMINATION OF SALARY AND OTHER CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT OF JUDGES OF THE NATIONAL COURT

I, Tore Lokoloko, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Organic Law on the Terms and Conditions of Employment of Judges and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council given after receiving a report from the Public Services Commission, hereby determine that the salary and other conditions of employment of William Thomas Prentice and Edmund Peter Tom Raine as Judges of the National Court on and from 6th February, 1978 are as set out in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Salary	In accordance with office held, the equivalent in kina of salaries and allowances payable to the Chief Judge and Judges of the Federal Court of Australia, as varied from time to time.
Housing	A house of appropriate standard and location to be provided at Port Moresby for which rent and housing subsidy is payable at normal Government rates. Judge to be confirmed in occupation of existing house. Maintenance to be provided as from 6th February, 1978.
Furniture	Items of furniture to be provided free of charge on a scale appropriate to a Departmental Head.
Domestic services	Water, power and garbage—all charges payable by Judge.
Telephone	Official telephone to be installed and maintained in Judge's residence and all costs, including the cost of calls, to be met by Government.
Removal expenses on leaving Papua New Guinea					First class fares to be paid from Papua New Guinea to the capital city in Judge's home state for Judge and family and also freight on furniture, personal effects, car, towable boat and law library.
Re-settlement grant on leaving Papua New Guinea					K2 300.
Recreation leave fares	First class return fares between Papua New Guinea and capital city of Judge's home state to be provided for Judge, his wife and dependant children under 18 years of age once each year.
Travelling allowance	When travelling on official duty a travelling allowance is payable as follows:— Within Papua New Guinea—K10 per day in addition to accommodation and all meals. Within Australia and elsewhere—current rates payable in Australia (kina equivalent).
Recreation leave	Two calendar months annual vacation accruing pro-rata with leave fares be granted, to be taken normally over the period of the Court vacation from December to February, subject to Court commitments and an equivalent period of annual leave with leave fares to be granted to any Judges required to remain on duty during the Court vacation. (Accumulated pro-rata recreation leave entitlements as at 1st January, 1972 are preserved).
Long leave	Three months with full pay in respect of each six years of service to be taken in conjunction with Court vacation or otherwise by arrangement with the Chief Justice. In respect of period of service in excess of six years, further long leave accrues on a pro-rata basis of one-twenty-fourth of a month for each completed month of service. On leaving Papua New Guinea Judge to receive accrued long leave or salary in lieu thereof. If he has served less than six years Judge to receive pro-rata long leave or salary in lieu thereof on above basis.
Furlough	On leaving Papua New Guinea the Judge shall be granted furlough or salary in lieu thereof on the basis of one-eighth of a month for each completed three months of service for the first four years of service and one-sixteenth of a month for each completed three months thereafter.
Gratuity	A Judge will be entitled to payment of an amount equal to 1.25 times the rate of gross annual salary payable to him in respect of his service on the Court being the rate that is applicable on the day before the day on which his service as a Judge is terminated. The amount will be payable in consequence of the retirement of the Judge from the Court or the termination of his office or employment as a Judge of the Court.
Sick leave and other special leave					Sick leave and other special leave shall be as determined by the appropriate authority in any particular case.
Travel expenses of Judge's wife					The fares of the Judge's wife shall be provided where she accompanies the Judge on circuit. No part of the wife's expenses other than the fares shall be met.
Attendance at law convention	Attendance at, and time spent by the Judge in travelling to and from an Australian Law Convention shall be regarded as a duty period. The cost of the fares of the Judge and his wife necessarily incurred in travelling to and from the Convention and travelling allowance shall be paid for the period involved. Any other expenses incurred shall be the Judge's own responsibility.
Death of Judge	Payment of removal expenses, re-settlement grant for widow, salary in lieu of accrued recreation and long leave and furlough to be paid to Judge's widow or dependants or in the case of an unmarried Judge without dependants to his estate.

Associates	Subject to Government policy on localisation Judge is entitled to an Associate of his own choice.
Secretarial Assistants	Adequate secretarial stenographic services to be provided.
