## Organic Law on Provincial Government

CHARTER**GRANTING PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT TO THE EAST NEW BRITAIN PROVINCE****WHEREAS**

(1) immediately before the commencement of the Organic Law on Provincial Government (hereinafter called "the Organic Law") there was established a provincial government body in respect of the East New Britain Province; and

(2) by Section 109 of the Organic Law the National Parliament shall be deemed to have made a resolution under Section 4 of the Organic Law that the National Executive Council be authorized to approve the grant of provincial government, and the granting of a Charter under Section 6 of the Organic Law, to the East New Britain Province; and

(3) the provincial constituent assembly for the East New Britain Province on Thursday the 12th day of May, 1977 adopted, in accordance with Part III of the Organic Law, a constitution for the East New Britain Province that is not inconsistent with the National Constitution or the Organic Law; and

(4) the National Executive Council has advised me to grant provincial government to the East New Britain Province,

NOW THEREFORE I, Tore Lokoloko, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the Organic Law and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, by this Charter grant, in the name and on behalf of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea, provincial government to the East New Britain Province.

## Organic Law on Provincial Government

CHARTER**GRANTING PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT TO THE EASTERN HIGHLANDS PROVINCE****WHEREAS**

(1) immediately before the commencement of the Organic Law on Provincial Government (hereinafter called "the Organic Law") there was established a provincial government body in respect of the Eastern Highlands Province; and

(2) by Section 199 of the Organic Law the National Parliament shall be deemed to have made a resolution under Section 4 of the Organic Law that the National Executive Council be authorized to approve the grant of provincial government, and the granting of a Charter under Section 6 of the Organic Law, to the Eastern Highlands Province; and

(3) the provincial constituent assembly for the Eastern Highlands Province on Friday the 13th day of May, 1977 adopted, in accordance with Part III of the Organic Law, a constitution for the Eastern Highlands Province that is not inconsistent with the National Constitution or the Organic Law; and

(4) the National Executive Council has advised me to grant provincial government to the Eastern Highlands Province,

NOW THEREFORE I, Tore Lokoloko, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the Organic Law and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, by this Charter grant, in the name and on behalf of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea, provincial government to the Eastern Highlands Province.
