Organic Law on Provincial Government

CHARTER

GRANTING PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT TO THE CENTRAL PROVINCE

WHEREAS

(1) immediately before the commencement of the Organic Law on Provincial Government (hereinafter called "the Organic Law") there was established a provincial government body in respect of the Central Province; and

(2) by Section 109 of the Organic Law the National Parliament shall be deemed to have made a resolution under Section 4 of the Organic Law that the National Executive Council be authorized to approve the grant of provincial government, and the granting of a Charter under Section 6 of the Organic Law, to the Central Province; and

(3) the provincial constituent assembly for the Central Province on the 20th day of June, 1977 adopted, in accordance with Part III of the Organic Law, a constitution for the Central Province that is not inconsistent with the National Constitution or the Organic Law; and

(4) the National Executive Council has advised me to grant provincial government to the Central Province,

NOW THEREFORE I, Tore Lokoloko, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the Organic Law and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, by this Charter grant, in the name and on behalf of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea, provincial government to the Central Province.

Public Finances Regulation 1974

ESTABLISHMENT OF THE CIVIL AVIATION AGENCY SUPPLY AND TENDERS BOARD

I, Julius Chan, Minister for Finance, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 17 of the Public Finances Regulation 1974 and all other powers me enabling and acting on the advice of the Secretary for Finance, hereby—

(a) establish the Civil Aviation Agency Supply and Tenders Board and appoint each of the following persons to be members of the Board:—

(i) Superintendent of Supply and Transport, Civil Aviation Agency (Chairman); and

(ii) Senior Contracts Officer, Civil Aviation Agency; and

(iii) Assistant Accountant (Budget and Costing), Civil Aviation Agency; and

(b) appoint a deputy for each of the following members of the Board:—

(i) in the case of the Superintendent of Supply and Transport, the Accountant, Civil Aviation Agency; and

(ii) in the case of the Senior Contracts Officer, the Senior Inventory Officer, Civil Aviation Agency; and

(iii) in the case of the Assistant Accountant (Budget and Costing), the Assistant Accountant (General), Civil Aviation Agency; and

(c) determine that the limits of authority and jurisdiction of the Board shall be to invite tenders for specialized goods and services necessary for the efficient operation of the Civil Aviation Agency for—

(i) the purchase and disposal of stores; and

(ii) the supply of works and services,

for and on behalf of the State to a value estimated by the Board not to exceed K50 000; and

(d) fix a quorum for a meeting to be three persons of whom no more than one shall be a deputy.

PRICES ORDER No. 199

being

A Prices Order relating to the maximum retail price of

BEER

MADE by the Acting Price Controller under the provisions of the *Prices Regulation Act 1949*, to come into operation on the date of publication of this Order in the *National Gazette*.

1. CITATION.

This Order may be cited as Prices Order No. 199.

Prices Order No. 199—continued

2. REVOCATION.

Prices Orders Numbers 195 and 198 are hereby revoked.

3. DEFINITIONS.

In this Order—

"beer" means ale, lager, porter, stout, and any other description of beer which is manufactured in Papua New Guinea and sold as a description of beer;

"chilled", in relation to beer, means at a temperature of six degrees Celsius (43 degrees Fahrenheit) or less;

"retail" means for the purpose of consumption or use.

4. MAXIMUM RETAIL PRICE.

Subject to Section 5 of this Order, the maximum price per carton at which beer may be sold by retail at a locality specified in Column 1 of the Schedule is—

(a) in the case of beer that is not chilled—the price specified in Column 2 of the Schedule opposite the locality concerned; and

(b) in the case of chilled beer—the price specified in Column 2 of the Schedule opposite the locality concerned, plus 20t.

5. EFFECT OF RETAIL SALES TAX.

Where beer sold at a locality specified in Column 1 of the Schedule is subject to a retail sales tax lawfully imposed in respect of the Province in which that locality is situated, the maximum price per carton at which beer may be sold by retail at that locality is the relevant price referred to in Section 4 of this Order plus the amount of provincial retail tax per carton.

6. DISPLAY OF PRICES.

A person or organisation who has in his custody or under his control any beer for sale by retail, or who offers, exhibits or exposes any of that beer for sale by retail, shall display a ticket, label, placard or notice attached to or exhibited or displayed with the beer setting forth in a prominent position in clear and legible figures easily discernible to any person inspecting such beer, the price at which the beer concerned may be bought.
