To: The Speaker of the National Parliament
GREETINGS!

WHEREAS the Constitution of Papua New Guinea, by Section 249, provides, amongst other things, that every Member of the National Parliament shall, before entering upon the duties of or exercising any of the powers of his office, make the Declaration of Office and the Declaration of Loyalty before a person appointed for the purposes by the Head of State in the forms set out in Schedule 3 and Section 6 respectively of the Constitution;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Tore Lokoloko, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, hereby appoint you to administer, from time to time, the Declarations to those Members who have not already made their Declarations since their election to the National Parliament.

Organic Law on Provincial Government

CHARTER

GRANTING PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT TO THE WESTERN PROVINCE

WHEREAS

(1) immediately before the commencement of the Organic Law on Provincial Government (hereinafter called "the Organic Law") there was established a provincial government body in respect of the Western Province; and

(2) by Section 109 of the Organic Law the National Parliament shall be deemed to have made a resolution under Section 4 of the Organic Law that the National Executive Council be authorized to approve the grant of provincial government, and the granting of a Charter under Section 6 of the Organic Law, to the Western Province; and

(3) the provincial constituent assembly for the Western Province on Tuesday, 12th July, 1977 adopted, in accordance with Part III of the Organic Law, a constitution for the Western Province that is not inconsistent with the National Constitution or the Organic Law; and

(4) the National Executive Council has advised me to grant provincial government to the Western Province,

NOW THEREFORE I, Tore Lokoloko, G.C.M.G., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the Organic Law and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, by this Charter grant, in the name and on behalf of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea, provincial government to the Western Province.

- (b) require, as a condition of the supply of goods or services to another enterprise, that that enterprise acquire all or part of its requirements of goods or services of another class directly or indirectly from a second enterprise;
- (c) induce another enterprise to refuse to deal with a second enterprise except on terms disadvantageous to the second enterprise;
- (d) engage in price cutting with the object of substantially damaging the business of a competitor or preventing a possible competitor from entering into competition with it; or
- (e) impose prices or other terms or conditions of dealing that it would be unable to impose but for its dominant position in the market of Papua New Guinea;
- (f) make it known to another enterprise that the Enterprise shall not supply goods to that other enterprise unless the other enterprise agrees to sell those goods at a price not less than the specified one by the Enterprise.

12. The proprietors for the time being of the Enterprise shall not transfer or offer to transfer any interest in the Enterprise without first notifying NIDA in writing.

13. The Enterprise shall not without the prior approval of the Minister carry on the activities for which it is registered in any location in Papua New Guinea other than Section 8, Lot 2, Mary Street, Port Moresby.

14. Other than the partners, only Papua New Guineans shall be employed by the Enterprise unless prior approval to do otherwise is granted to the Enterprise by the Secretary for Labour, Commerce and Industry.
