2. SIGNATURES REQUIRED.

Each nomination must be signed by not less than two (2) contributors and must contain the consent of the person nominated to act if elected.

3. CONSENT MAY BE WITHDRAWN.

A candidate may withdraw his consent to his nomination at any time on or before the day fixed for the close of nominations by lodging with the returning officer a notice of withdrawal, bearing his signature and witnessed by a contributor.

4. RETURNING OFFICER.

The Electoral Commissioner for Papua New Guinea is the returning officer for the purpose of this election and shall make all necessary arrangements for the conduct of the election.

10. WHERE BALLOT-PAPER NOT RECEIVED.

If a contributor who is entitled to vote has not received his ballot material, he may, before the close of the poll, apply to the returning officer or an assistant returning officer, who may issue the ballot material to the contributor.
