Industrial Relations Act (Chapter 174)

ADJUSTMENT OF MINIMUM WAGES BOARD DETERMINATION No. 1 OF 1983

1. The Consumer Price Index (C.P.I.) as calculated by the Bureau of Statistics has shown a percentage increase in the index for the period 1st January to 31st December, 1983, of 8.50 percent (rounded from 8.49%).
2. Clause 5.2 of the Determination prescribes the manner of calculating the increase for Level 1 and Level 2 centres.
3. Clause 5.3 of the Determination prescribes the manner of calculating the increase of wages for the National Rural Minimum Wage.
4. Clause 5.131 of the Determination prescribes the date of effect of the increase in wages.
5. The National Minimum Wages payable with effect on and from 1st March 1984 under the provisions of the Minimum Wages Board Determination No. 1 of 1983 are:
