The Ombudsman Commission, having investigated suspected misconduct in office by Charles Punaha, Chief Executive Officer of Papua New Guinea Radiocommunications and Telecommunications Technical Authority (PANGTEL), he being a person to whom Division III.2 of the Constitution and the *Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership* apply, having granted that person a right to be heard and having deliberated on the matter, hereby gives notice that it has determined in its deliberate judgment pursuant to Section 29(1) of the Constitution and Sections 17(d), 20(4) and 27(1)(a) of the *Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership*:

- (a) that there is a prima facie case that that person has been guilty of misconduct in office; and
- (b) that the matter has been referred to the Public Prosecutor and if he decides to prosecute the matter, he shall so prosecute before an independent leadership tribunal established under Section 28(1)(g) of the Constitution and Section 27(7) of the *Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership*; and
